
After enjoying lunch together, Rabbi Lewis will conduct a study session entitled "Peacemaking: The Central Pillar In Torah"

He lived in Jerusalem for almost three years and is a frequent traveler to Israel. Rabbi Lewis has an abiding interest in reconciliation efforts in the Middle East. In 2012 he published a book on peaceful conflict resolution within Jewish sources entitled

The Torah of Reconciliation.
